

# Makerspace

## Student Safety Contract

Makerspace is very hands-on. You may be doing activities that require the use of hot or sharp objects. Safety in makerspace is the #1 priority for students, teachers and parents. To ensure a safe space, students need to understand and follow these rules.

### GENERAL RULES

1. Always follow instructions carefully. If you don't understand something – ask!
2. Always grab your lanyard before you begin working.
3. Wait to touch tools/equipment until instructed to do so.
4. Only use tools that you have been trained to use safely.
5. Always use tools as they are intended to be used. For example, do not use a screwdriver as a hammer.
6. Think through your entire project before you start – figure out what you will need and how you will make it.
7. Use the Project Planning sheet.
8. Report any accident or injury to teachers immediately. Even something as small as a papercut.
9. Know where the Band-Aids and the First Aid kit are.
10. Know what safety equipment we have and where it is located.
11. Always wear protective gear when needed. Safety goggles when taking things apart, for example.
12. Always clean up any messes you make.
13. Make sure all equipment is unplugged, and put away, before leaving.
14. If you use anything hot (hot glue gun, 3Doodler), leave it on the Hot Spot.
15. If you break a tool, replace it.
16. **If you use any consumables, bring in something from home**, see attached wish list for ideas of what to bring in.
